MAJOR PUSH BEFORE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING

Time to get strategic and focused!

NAC is taking action in three major strategy areas:

1) Public input via LETTER WRITING CAMPAIGN-

WE NEED YOU AND A FRIEND TO WRITE A LETTER to all five Supervisors! We need letters to address the applicable issues to their responsibilities as REPRESENTATIVES of the people and their sworn commitment to "the implementation of policies and the provision of services that will enhance the economic, environmental and social quality of life in San Luis Obispo County."

- 2) Developing a feasible, realistic and appropriate map that fits in keeping Nipomo rural, bringing TRUE "affordable" housing to the area while protecting the natural resources that make this area special.
- 3) Continue to examine legal remedies by which WE can deter the worst aspects of this mega-development from coming to fruition. There are a number of possibilities and NAC has secured legal counsel and other experts who are assisting us with these efforts.
